The Go Yellow 5K Sponsored Walk will take place on **Tuesday 25th May 2010 (date change due to additional in-service day, will revert back to June in 2011)** at Bellahouston Park and, as with previous years, we are approaching various organisations in the hope that they will again provide a range of organised sports and entertainment throughout the day. We already have a great range of outdoor sporting and fund activities lined up, which always goes down well with the children!

The children will be encouraged to sign up family and friends to raise as much sponsorship as they can for their 5k walk around Bellahouston Park. Remember, all children are welcome to join us regardless of the size of your class. Community fundraising team regularly visit schools to speak about the work of the Hospice and are equipped with a presentation geared towards the higher primary years.
